## MISSIONARY CO-OPERATIVE APPEAL NEXT SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 16th, 2012





## Traditional Propers Fifteenth Sunday After Pentecost

Vestments: Green

**INTROIT:** Psalm 85: 1, 2-4 Bow down Thy ear, O Lord, to me and hear me: Save Thy servant, O my God, that trusteth in Thee all day. *Ps.* Give joy to the soul of Thy servant; for to Thee, O Lord, I have lifted up my soul. Glory be to the Father.

**COLLECT** Lord, may Thy continual pity cleanse and defend Your Church, and, since it cannot be preserved in safety without You, govern it always by Your Providence. Through our Lord.

EPISTLE: Galatians 5: 25-26; 6:1-10 Brethren: If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. Let us not be made desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another. Brethren, and if any man be overtaken in any fault, you, who are spiritual, instruct such a one in the Spirit of meekness, considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted. Bear ye one another's burdens, and so you shall fulfill the law of Christ. For if any man thinks himself to be something, whereas he is nothing, he deceiveth himself. But let everyone prove his own work, and so he shall have glory in himself only, and not in another. For everyone shall bear his own burden. And let him that is instructed in the word, communicate to him that instructeth him, in all good things. Be not deceived: God is not mocked; for what things a man shall sow, those also shall he reap. For he that soweth in his flesh, of the flesh shall reap corruption: but he that soweth in the spirit, of the spirit shall reap life everlasting. And in doing good, let us not fail; for in due time we shall reap, not failing. Therefore, whilst we have time, let us work good to all men, but especially to those who are of the household of the faith.
